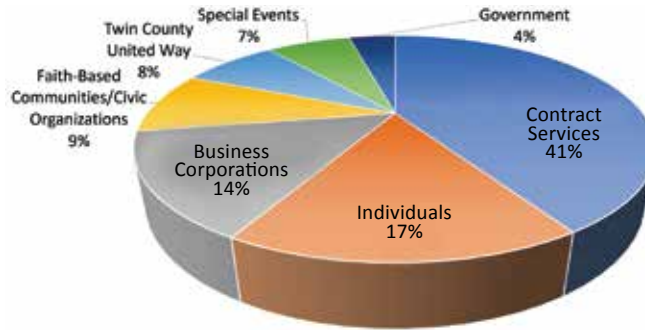

Volunteers provide transportation to and from health care appointments, pharmacy and grocery shopping. If you wish to visit a spouse in a facility, we are here for you. Volunteers use their own vehicles to provide this service.

We traveled 65,515 miles this year to help those in need. That is over two times around the globe!



 **22 ramps built or re-built**

Some of our neighbors find it difficult, if not impossible to leave their home as stairs become a major obstacle. In response, we build wheelchair ramps to allow them access in and out of their home. The usual lead time on building ramps is 4-6 weeks.

 **49 safety modifications or minor home repairs**

Following a home assessment, our volunteers can assist with safety modifications or minor home repairs such as, installing a bathroom grab bar or stair rail. The usual lead time on these projects is a minimum of 10 days.
